

Counseling

Our social workers and counselors can put you back on the right path by helping you find counseling or referrals to programs for drug, alcohol or behavioral health issues.

Outpatient Care

You are covered for a combined annual total of 50 visits for outpatient mental health treatment. Co-payments will apply.



Inpatient Behavioral or Alcohol/Substance Abuse Treatment

If you need to be hospitalized, the Member Assistance Program will help to coordinate your care. You are covered for:

Behavioral Health:

 Medically necessary inpatient behavioral health treatment in an acute care hospital for a maximum of 30 days per calendar year.*

Alcohol/Substance Abuse:

- Inpatient detoxification: up to 7 days within a 12-month period, maximum twice per lifetime
- Inpatient rehabilitation: up to
 30 days within a 12-month
 period, maximum twice per
 lifetime

Other Social Services

Besides counseling and support, we can connect you with community resources that can help.
